West coast water temperatures vary between 8-10 Degrees Celsius (48-50 F) in the winter, to around 19 Degrees Celsius in the summer at a water depth of 20 m or 66 ft. Visibility remains good at 12 m and deeper. The abundance of life is year round and kelp forests can best be seen in summer and autumn.
